Information and access to personal data pursuant to art. 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 (General data protection regulation).

This privacy notice is provided to you, pursuant to art. 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 – General Data Protection Regulation, and in relation to personal data that the Orchestra Consortium partners (hereinafter Partners) acquire as a result of the completion of the “Data Access Application Form” in the ORCHESTRA Data Portal <https://dataportal.orchestra-cohort.eu/>

The purpose of processing and legal basis for processing

The purpose of processing your personal data is perform all the necessary activities to evaluate your eligibility through the ORCHESTRA Data Portal, and then to provide you data access.

The legal basis for the processing of the personal data you provide is the satisfaction of your request to access the Orchestra Portal ((art. 6, par.1, let. b), the performance of a task carried out in the public interest ((art. 6, par.1, let. e), and the legitimate interest of the Partners to previously assess the suitability of the requests (art. 6, par. 1, let. f).

Recipients and categories of recipients of personal data

The recipients of the data you provide are the Partners and any data Processors appointed by them.

Your personal data will not undergo dissemination.

Data storage period

The determination of the storage period of your personal data is in accordance with the principle of processing requirements. Your personal data will therefore only be stored for the entire period of validity of your personal access to the Orchestra Data Portal.

Rights of the data subject

Please note that with reference to your provided personal data, you have the following rights:

1. to access your personal data
2. to obtain the rectification of your personal data or the limitation of the processing operations concerning you
3. to obtain the erasure of your personal data

4. to object to processing
5. to the portability of data (law applicable only to data in electronic form), as governed by art. 20 of EU Regulation 2016/679
6. to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority

Partners are required to provide a reply within one month of the request, extendable up to three months in case of complexity of the request. Please note that you can request to correct or erase personal data entered incorrectly at any time, by sending a request to orchestra@cineca.it

Mandatory or optional nature of providing the data and the consequences of failure to provide the data

Providing data is mandatory in order to access the platform <https://dataportal.orchestra-cohort.eu/> and consequently carry out your request. Failure to provide the data will prevent you from obtaining the service access credentials.
